YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM FOR CULTURAL ARTS

In our efforts to preserve and share the Hawaiian and Polynesian Arts and Culture, Ke Kukui Foundation is proud to offer youth scholarships to eligible families enrolling in our cultural programs. Applicants must pre-register for desired classes before submitting an application.

IS MY CHILD ELIGIBLE?

Applicants must be age 3-18 years old or 19-22 years old if enrolled in college AND must fulfill at least one of the following criteria:

**Applicants that fulfill criteria #1 will have top priority.*

- 1) Family income must be within the income eligibility guidelines established by the Federal Income Guidelines for free and reduced price meals. Review qualifications in the table below.
- 2) Family is in need of financial aid for extra curricular activities but family income does *not* fall within the eligibility guidelines established by the Federal Income Guidelines for free and reduced price meals. Review qualifications in the table below.
- 3) Family has 3 or more immediate family members (ages 3-18 or 19-22 if enrolled in college) enrolled/enrolling in Kaleinani O Ke Kukui cultural programs.

Ke Kukui Foundation currently has three (3) full scholarship and six (6) half scholarship opportunities available for eligible families in 2020.



SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

- This scholarship is only applicable cultural programs offered at Kaleinani O Ke Kukui. Check current classes here: <http://kaleinani.com/classes>.
- A full scholarship may be granted to recipients who qualify for free meals. This covers 100% of the annual tuition for one (1) class.
- A half scholarship may be granted to those who qualify for reduced price meals. This covers 50% of the annual tuition for one (1) class. Recipient must pay 50% of the monthly tuition.
- The scholarship is valid for up to one (1) year as long as all requirements are met.
- Registration fees, class supplies, and costuming is not covered by the scholarship.

SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

The following requirements must be met to retain the scholarship:

- 15 volunteer hours with Ke Kukui Foundation must be fulfilled by a parent/guardian and teen recipients during the scholarship year.
- Recipient is required to attend at least 75% of classes. Kumu (teacher) must be notified of absences in advance.
- Recipients will be assigned a home project to complete by a given deadline.
- Recipient must abide by all hālau (school) rules.
